Comments: I wish to thank the Senate Committee on Ways and Means for this opportunity to testify on HB321. I OPPOSE HB321. The bill simply creates another window of opportunity for voting fraud and will not accomplish its stated intention. This bill, like so many other voter registration bills is predicated on the assumption that the low voter turn-out in Hawaii is somehow due to the requirement to be registered at least 30 days ahead of polling and that same day registration will somehow significantly increase voter participation. I believe that nothing could be further from the truth. In fact, I assert that the real reason for low turnout is the vast political apathy of the general population in Hawaii where a day of good surfing will ultimately take precedence over any voting activity. (Personally, I would just as soon not want to see this demographic increase their participation in the electoral process in any event.)
