
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUNTING LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 183D-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The hunting license fee shall be:

4 (1) \$10 for any person who has resided in the State for
5 one year or longer, [~~or who~~] is a member of the armed
6 forces of the United States on active duty [~~and~~] or
7 the spouse [~~and children~~] or child thereof, or [~~who~~]
8 elects to forgo the exemption provided in paragraph
9 [~~(4)~~] (3);

10 [~~(2)~~] ~~\$95 for all other persons,~~

11 [~~(3)~~] (2) \$50 for a three-day period and \$95 for a seven-
12 day period for hunting on a private and commercial
13 shooting preserve for persons who do not meet the
14 requirements of paragraph (1) [~~or (4); and~~], (3), or
15 (4);

16 [~~(4)~~] (3) Free to [~~all~~] any Hawaii [~~residents~~] resident
17 sixty-five years of age or older and to [~~all persons~~]



- 1 any person with Hansen's disease who [are residents]
2 is a resident of Kalaupapa, Molokai[-];
3 (4) \$3 for any qualified disabled veteran who is a
4 resident of the State. For purposes of this
5 paragraph, "qualified disabled veteran" means an
6 honorably discharged veteran who:
7 (A) Upon submitting an initial application for a
8 hunting license, has at least a sixty per cent
9 service-connected disability, as defined by the
10 Veterans Benefits Administration, consisting of:
11 (i) The loss of the use of a lower extremity; or
12 (ii) A disability rating of sixty per cent or
13 more,
14 and who is receiving compensation from the United
15 States for the disability; or
16 (B) Is the recipient of a purple heart from the
17 United States Department of Defense; and
18 (5) \$95 for all other persons."

19 SECTION 2. Section 183D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
20 amended to read as follows:

21 "**§183D-23 Licenses expire when.** All licenses shall expire
22 on June 30 next following the date of issuance, except for



1 licenses obtained pursuant to section [~~183D-22(b)(3)~~.] 183D-
2 22(b)(2) and (4). A license issued pursuant to section 183D-
3 22(b)(4) shall expire upon the death of the licensee. Nothing
4 in this section shall be construed to prohibit the department
5 from suspending or revoking any hunting license."

6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
