
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 712-1250.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (4) to read as follows:

3 "(4) Promoting intoxicating liquor to a person under the
4 age of twenty-one is a petty misdemeanor. Any person convicted
5 of violating this section shall be sentenced as follows:

6 (a) For a first conviction, to a minimum term of
7 imprisonment of no less than twenty-four hours;

8 (b) For a second conviction within five years, to a term
9 of imprisonment of no fewer than twenty days; and

10 (c) For a third or subsequent conviction within five years
11 of the first conviction, to a term of imprisonment of
12 no fewer than thirty days."

13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
15 begun, before its effective date.

16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

Report Title:

Promoting Liquor to Minors; Sentencing

Description:

Changes classification of the offense of promoting intoxicating liquor to a minor from misdemeanor to a petty misdemeanor. Requires a minimum 24-hour imprisonment for the first offense. Authorizes longer imprisonment term for second, and third or subsequent offenses.
