
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ADOPT
RULES TO MANAGE MANTA RAY DIVE SITES.

1 WHEREAS, the manta ray night dive is a popular activity in
2 West Hawaii, and visitors visit Hawaii Island for the purpose of
3 participating in this activity; and

5 WHEREAS, these dives occur at specific locations where
6 manta rays are known to frequent; and

8 WHEREAS, the popularity of this activity has grown over the
9 years and now there are many boats, kayaks, stand up paddle
10 boards, swimmers, divers, snorkelers, and other recreational and
11 commercial users present at these sites at the same time
12 creating a potentially dangerous situation; and

14 WHEREAS, if an accident occurred, it would be not only
15 tragic, but harmful to the diving industry, and a potential
16 liability to the State; and

18 WHEREAS, ensuring the safety of workers, visitors, and
19 manta rays, and ensuring a good visitor experience is in the
20 best interest of all; now, therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
23 Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
24 Session of 2014, the Senate concurring, that the Department of
25 Land and Natural Resources is urged to adopt rules to better
26 manage specific manta ray dive sites to ensure that safety and
27 order is maintained; and

3 Board of Land and Natural Resources.
