<u>HB 620, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR531)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION. Prohibits a plastic product from being labeled as compostable unless it meets ASTM D6400 standards. (HB620 HD1)	EEP, CPC
<u>HB 264, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR493)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO ENERGY. Requires the PUC to establish a process for the creation of integrated energy districts. (HB264 HD1)	EEP, CPC

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony no later than 24 hours prior to the hearing. Persons submitting testimony on the day of the hearing **MUST** submit 22 copies at the hearing. Staff will not be able to make copies. Testimony should indicate:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;
- The date and time of the hearing; and
- Measure number.

While every effort will be made to incorporate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:

PAPER: 22 copies (including an original) to Room 304 in the State Capitol;

FAX: For testimony less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 808-586-6211 (Oahu) or 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islander without a computer to submit testimony through e-mail or the Web); or

WEB: For testimony less than 10MB in size, transmit from <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/submittestimony.aspx>.
