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| <u>SB 12</u> Status & Testimony | RELATING TO THE SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY FLEXIBILITY ACT. Entitles the small business regulatory review board to a separate line item within the budget of the department of business, economic development, and tourism. | EDT, WAM |

Establishes and appropriates funds for the manufacturing development program, through which the high technology development corporation shall distribute grants to Hawaii manufacturers for various activities.

RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY.

Expands the current Hawaii small business innovation research program by providing matching funds for phase II and phase III awards in the interest of diversifying and stimulating Hawaii's economy. Repeals the requirement that the high technology development corporation adopt administrative rules for the implementation of the program, including rules to specify eligibility requirements, priorities, and preferences for grants.
