<u>HB 1126, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR643)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires the state procurement office to establish a database of all government procurement contracts, accessible to each governmental entity. Requires state procurement office oversight of procurement information. Appropriates funds to establish the database. (HB1126 HD1)	GVO, WAM
<u>HB 1127, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR644)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires all procurement officers of state and county government bodies to attend initial training by the State Procurement Office and regular follow-up training as determined by the State Procurement Office. Appropriates funds. (HB1127 HD1)	GVO, JDL/WAM
<u>HB 1180, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR629)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Requires the state procurement office to establish a database to record inadequate past performance by contractors on public works projects. (HB1180 HD1)	GVO, WAM
<u>HB 1292, HD2</u> <u>(HSCR790)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PROCUREMENT. Establishes a past performance task force to establish the factors that should be considered when evaluating a contractor's past performance for the purposes of awarding a contract under Chapters 103D and 103F, Hawaii Revised Statutes. (HB1292 HD2)	GVO, WAM
<u>HB 1366</u> <u>(HSCR584)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO STATE ACQUISITION OR DEVELOPMENT OF REAL PROPERTY. Appropriates funds to identify, plan, and acquire or build upon real property in urban Honolulu to provide office space for state governmental agencies and offices	GVO, WAM
