<a href="#"><u>SB 465</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO GOVERNMENT RECORDS. Amends the Sunshine Law to expressly allow certain government records to be shared among public board members where no commitment relating to a vote on the matter is made or sought.	JDL
<a href="#"><u>SB 652</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS. Requires a public agency board to report any final action taken during an executive meeting; provided that such disclosure is not inconsistent with the purpose of convening the executive meeting and confidentiality is maintained.	JDL
<a href="#"><u>SB 509</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS. Requires the attorney general to prepare a statement for each proposed constitutional amendment in plain English that indicates the purpose, limitations, and effects of the proposed amendment. Requires the attorney general to distribute each statement to the state office of elections and all county clerks for further distribution. Requires the office of elections and county clerks to make each statement available to the public in all physical or online sites where they make proposed constitutional amendment questions available to the public.	JDL
<a href="#"><u>SB 202</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING. Amends the reporting requirements of noncandidate committees to include identification of a ballot issue being advocated for or against.	JDL
<a href="#"><u>GM 513</u></a> <a href="#"><u>Status &amp; Testimony</u></a>	Submitting for consideration and confirmation to the Attorney General of the Department of the Attorney General, Gubernatorial Nominee, DOUGLAS CHIN, for a term to expire 12-3-2018.	JDL
