<a href="#">SB 269, SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR25)</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO PUBLIC ORDER. Establishes the process and grounds for a person to petition the court to vacate a conviction for obstructing or occupying a public place on grounds that the person was homeless at the time of committing the offense. (SD1)	HSB, JDL
<a href="#">SB 752</a> <a href="#">(SSCR81)</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. Requires telecommunications carriers to release individuals from shared or family wireless plans, without charge, upon written request in documented instances of domestic violence.	CPN, JDL
<a href="#">SB 226, SD1</a> <a href="#">(SSCR293)</a> <a href="#">Status &amp; Testimony</a>	RELATING TO ABUSE OF FAMILY OR HOUSEHOLD MEMBER. Adds the definition of "business day" to the offense of abuse of a family or household member. Repeals the forty-eight hour no contact provision and specifies that the period of separation that a police officer shall order the person who the police officer reasonably believes to have inflicted the abuse of a family or household member commences when the order is issued and expires at 6:00 p.m. on the second business day following the day the order was issued.
