Status and Testimony | RELATING TO FORENSIC IDENTIFICATION.
Specifies the requirements of DNA sample collection from subject criminal offenders that are released on parole, probation, or other release. Makes it a class C felony to intentionally or knowingly fail to provide DNA samples, and a misdemeanor for negligent or reckless failure to comply. | JDL |

Status and Testimony | RELATING TO THE RETENTION OF BIOLOGICAL EVIDENCE.
Specifies the criminal offenses for which biological evidence must be retained for a certain period following a conviction and the standards for uses of retained evidence. Establishes a process for the disposal of biological evidence earlier than the prescribed period for retention. | JDL |
