Status & Testimony</p> | <p>RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA.
Allows a qualifying patient, parent, primary caregiver, or an owner or employee of a medical marijuana production center or dispensary to transport medical marijuana in any public place. Repeals the requirement that a certifying physician be the qualifying patient's primary care physician. Effective 7/1/2050 and contingent upon passage of S.B. No. 1302 (2015).
