<u>SB 1030, SD1</u> <u>(SSCR373)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Increases the minimum age for persons who may purchase tobacco products or electronic smoking devices from eighteen to twenty-one years of age. Amends the definition of "electronic smoking device" as used in section 709-908, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Defines "tobacco products". Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)	HTH/CPN, JDL
