HB 147, HD1 (HSCR609) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROCEDURE. Creates procedural and administrative requirements for law enforcement agencies for eyewitness identifications of suspects in criminal investigations. Grants a defendant the right to challenge an eyewitness identification to be used at trial in a pretrial evidentiary hearing. (HB147 HD1)	JDL, WAM
HB 452, HD1 (HSCR819) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO STATEWIDE SEXUAL ASSAULT SERVICES. Appropriates funds to the department of the attorney general for statewide sexual assault services for fiscal biennium 2016-2017. Beginning with the 2017-2018 fiscal year, sets a minimum base budget of the department of the attorney general for statewide sexual assault services. (HB452 HD1)	JDL, WAM
HB 26, HD1 (HSCR811) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE COMPENSATION OF TRUSTEES. Clarifies how trustees shall be compensated. (HB26 HD1)	JDL
HB 561, HD1 (HSCR617) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SOCIAL MEDIA. Prohibits employers from requiring or requesting employees and potential employees to grant access to personal account usernames and passwords. (HB561 HD1)	JDL
