<u>SB 1009, SD1</u> <u>(HSCR951)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO SERVICE CHARGES. Requires hotels to distribute porterage service charges to employees in full or disclose to customers that the charges are being used for other purposes. (SD1)	TOU, LAB, FIN
<u>SB 1101, SD1, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR936)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY. Extends the availability of the exemption from state civil service for persons hired or contracted by the Hawaii Public Housing Authority to repair and maintain vacant housing units. <u>SB 119</u> <u>(SSCR657)</u> <u>Status</u>	<p><b>MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.</b></p> <p>Makes appropriation for the public employment cost items of and cost adjustments for employees of the various legislative agencies.</p>	LAB, FIN
<u>SB 1174, SD2, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR991)</u> <u>Status</u>	<p><b>RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.</b></p> <p>Provides that an independent medical examination and permanent impairment rating examination shall be conducted by a qualified physician selected by the mutual agreement of the parties. <u>SB 1324, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR861)</u> <u>Status</u>	<p><b>RELATING TO DIVORCE.</b></p> <p>Provides statutory authority for the employees' retirement system administrator to make direct payment to a former spouse of a member of benefits or portion thereof pursuant to valid court judgment, order, or decree. Appropriates money to implement the purposes of this Act. Takes effect on 1/7/2059. (SD2)</p>	LAB, FIN



DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Testimony should indicate:

- Testifier's name with position/title and organization;
- The Committee(s) to which the comments are directed;
- The date and time of the hearing; and
- Measure number.

While every effort will be made to incorporate all testimony received, materials received on the day of the hearing or improperly identified or directed, may be distributed to the Committee after the hearing.

Submit testimony in ONE of the following ways:

FAX: For testimony less than 5 pages in length, transmit to 808-586-8544 (Oahu) or 1-800-535-3859 (for Neighbor Islander without a computer to submit testimony through e-mail or the Web); or

WEB: For testimony less than 10MB in size, transmit from <http://www.capitol.hawaii.gov/submittestimony.aspx>.
