RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY.

PSM

Allows committed persons to create approved products and crafts that may be sold through the correctional industries program. Requires that all moneys collected from the sale of products and crafts to be deposited into either the correctional industries revolving fund or the committed person's account. (Proposed SD1)
