<u>HB 564</u> <u>(HSCR723)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO VIETNAM WAR COMMEMORATION. Appropriates funds for programs, ceremonies, and activities commemorating the 50TH Anniversary of the Vietnam War.	PSM, WAM
<u>HB 1119</u> <u>(HSCR725)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO FILIPINO VETERANS. Appropriates funds for burial grants for qualifying Filipino veterans to provide funeral and burial services and transportation of their remains to the Philippines.	PSM, WAM
<u>HB 365, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR653)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO POLICE. Appropriates moneys as a grant-in-aid to the city and county of Honolulu to purchase body cameras for their police officers and to establish a Honolulu Police Department Body Camera Pilot Program, provided that the City and County of Honolulu provide matching funds on a 1:1 basis. (HB365 HD1)	PSM, WAM
<u>HB 456, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR747)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO POLICE DEPARTMENTS. Specifies that citizen complaints against a police officer that involve allegations of domestic abuse against a family or household member on the part of the police officer shall not be required to be in writing or sworn to by the complainant. (HB456 HD1)	PSM, JDL
<u>HB 87</u> <u>(HSCR589)</u> <u>Status & Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY. Shields process servers from prosecution under criminal trespass statutes when performing their duties.	PSM, JDL
