<u>SB 559, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR739)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE MILITARY. Expands the office of veterans' services to include military affairs and establishes additional duties of the office; and appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)	VMI, FIN
<u>SB 825, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR707)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO CULTURAL EXCHANGES BETWEEN HAWAII AND PUERTO RICO. Establishes the temporary Puerto Rican exchange commission to coordinate a cultural exchange program between Hawaii and Puerto Rico to honor and recognize the contributions of the Puerto Rican people and commemorate the arrival of the Puerto Ricans to Hawaii. Takes effect on 7/1/2050. (SD2)	VMI, FIN
<u>SB 1159, SD2</u> <u>(SSCR691)</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO VETERANS DISABILITY BENEFITS. Exempts federal veterans disability benefits from claims of creditors and attachment, levy, and seizure to enforce a court judgment, except for certain child and spousal support cases. Effective 01/07/2059. (SD2)	VMI, JUD


As this is a decision making meeting only, no public testimony will be accepted.
