Requires the department of land and natural resources to implement a public restroom maintenance system that includes restrooms located in areas under the jurisdiction of the department. Requires the department to establish an asset management system for public restrooms within the public restroom maintenance system. Makes an appropriation to the DLNR to establish and maintain the public restroom maintenance system.	WTL, WAM
SB 263 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO KE'EHĪ LAGOON BEACH PARK. Makes an appropriation for the replenishment of the beach at Ke'ehi lagoon beach park.	WTL, WAM
SB 893 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO WATER AND SEWER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS. Appropriates funds for research on water and sewer distribution systems on each island and a pilot study for advanced monitoring of water systems.	WTL, WAM
